CYBER SECRET pulled early when off the pace inside, moved closer along the rail late on the backstretch, moved out in the final turn, engaged the leader once straightened for home, wore that foe down in determined fashion while fully extended. GOLDEN RON got clear in the first turn along the inside, set a legitimate set of fractions while under light restraint, continued to show the way into the lane, responded when challenged by the winner, firmly roused, proved stubborn to the end under brisk handling. ATIGUN broke out and last, remained back, good gain while on the outside in the second turn, flattened out the final furlong. HERP devoid of early foot, remained back, four wide into the stretch when staging a mild rally, finished up evenly. DON DULCE raced back and off the pace, three wide trip, lacked a kick when called on in the drive. ENDORSEMENT within striking distance while racing outside, came up empty in the drive. ISMAEL GRANDE closest to the leader for five furlongs, gave way in the drive. Z ROCKSTAR forwardly placed in the early going, began a steady retreat after a half.
