TURN TO LASS dueled closest to the inside, breather into the far turn, shook clear when straightened for home, came out when she shied from the starting gate tracks late, held. ALL ELECTRIC narrowly showed the way early, dueled off rail in hand, fell back off the winner a furlong out, coming back late. YOURSMINEOURS settled off the pace toward the inside, moved a bit closer turning for home, moved to the outside for room, evenly late. LUCKY TUNNEL lacked speed, improved position by saving ground into the stretch, flattened out a bit, evenly in the drive. FOOLISHLY lacked a serious late response. SALTWATER RUNNER four wide late in the turn when moving a bit closer, sulked stretch, even late. INJUSTICE far back, five wide out of the second turn when moving bit closer. CRYPTOS' BEST lacked a response in the drive. RUN CAT RUN five wide late in the second turn, no gain. THORNHILL prompted the pace for six furlongs, gave way. REBEL LIL finished early.
