**Footnotes**

THEODORE'S CASH pushed out at the start, fell far back, continued far back in the run up the backstretch, began to move into the far turn, circled five wide into the lane when moving smartly, took over soon after and then drew well clear. ITALIAN BREEZE settled off the pace, fell back a bit further the middle half, came four wide into the lane, finished willingly to be up late for the place, no match for the winner. DELVIN'S A HATER closest to the leader, challenged put a head in front midway on the second turn, also proved no match for the winner in the final furlong, nipped late for the place. CRISTOVIA went evenly paced in lacking a winning response. DAZZLIN DALTON settled off the pace, also lacked a response in the drive. DRASCO broke out, raced well back, five wide in the second turn, improved slightly while not a threat in the drive. GOLD SILT settled off the pace, lodged a strong middle move to challenge in the second turn, hung in the drive. SIX FIRE sprinted clear to show the way through the first turn, larger lead after a half, gave way hen headed second turn. GOING STICK forwardly placed for a half, gave way. REASON TO HAR four wide, finished early.
