NOYOUCAN'T took over at the start, set the pace while off the inside, rated kindly, continued to show the way into the stretch, responded when challenged late, dug in late. W W OLMMA fell back off the early pace, moved out, rallied five wide turning for home, challenged outside the winner late, outkicked in the late going. ROCKIN MOMMA forwardly placed early along the inside, continued along the rail second turn, got through entering the stretch, could do little with the top two late. DREAM PEGASUS four down to three wide when forwardly placed through the first turn, remained within striking distance up the backstretch, had little left for the drive. SANDWEE last to leave, trailed, picked off a couple of tiring rivals while not a threat. COBRA KISS four wide through the first turn when off the pace, closer in the run up the backstretch, chased the winner into the far turn, began to weaken soon after. NETTIE HUGHES was never a threat.
