KEEPINONESTEPAHEAD void of early foot, came five wide into the lane, roused into the lane, finished willingly down the middle of the strip to be edging away at the wire. ONLINE CODE within striking distance, advanced and took over three wide late in the turn, got clear, could not contain the winner. GEORGE RAY off the early place inside, in traffic, blocked late in the turn, moved out to be four wide for the drive, mild rally to improve, clear for the show. C P IMPROVISE last away, raced well back, in some traffic while four wide into the lane, displayed a mild amount of late interest. MISTER MINISTER toward the inside behind the leaders, in some traffic turning for home, between foes midstretch, lacked a late kick. DRAGON HEART four wide late in the turn, had little left for the drive. MISTER H sprinted clear soon after the start, continued to set the pace through the turn, weakened when headed by the winner turning for home. BATESVILLE closest to the leader for a half, faltered.
