WHAT AFLIRT void of early foot, moved closer on the outside in the second turn, bid, gained the advantage and finished with good determination to finish on equal terms with ALMATY. ALMATY dueled early, pressured the leader up the backstretch, fell back far turn, fought back inside and earned the dead heat in game fashion. ATSA PRETTY MUFFIN set the pace, garnered a larger advantage in the second turn, no match for the top two while clear of the others. JIFFY WISH far back for six furlongs, displayed a modest amount of late interest. COCOA CREEK lacked a response in the drive. TRICKY DETAILS had nothing left for the stretch. SCARLET GLORY gave way after four furlongs.
