JIMANI forward from the start, took over from between rivals into the turn, shook clear entering the stretch, increased advantage under pressure. CAVIAR EMPTOR bothered at the start, raced back, steady advance turn while five wide, finished willingly to earn the place. RED AT THE HELM forwardly placed off the inside, three wide into the turn, weakened through the stretch. SMILIN' MINSTER came in at the start, was straightened and then turned in an even effort outside. PAN OUT saved ground to no avail. MISS SANTA ANITA void of early foot, swung out five wide exiting the turn, improved position. MISS TACT tired while four wide. WILD ENJOYMENT faded while racing off the rail. WHAT A SPLASH was not a threat. SAX'S TUNE broke alertly, flashed early foot and stopped. SOUTHERN ISSUE remained always back.
