SMOKE SMOKE SMOKE moved up soon after the start to press the pace, came in ever so slightly into the turn, took over the advantage entering the stretch, kept clear under steady handling. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF PROUD COMIC AGAINST THE WINNER FOR INTERFERENCE INTO THE TURN WAS NOT ALLOWED. RENO BOB last away, void of early foot, came on the far outside for the drive, up for the place down the middle of the strip. SIR LAFF ALOT broke well, allowed the pace to go early, waited briefly toward the inside late in the turn, brushed stretch, lacked needed kick when clear. PROUD COMIC steadied from between foes late on the backstretch, brushed stretch, finished evenly when clear. EXTRA EXCLUSIVE remained back throughout while saving ground. CITY CODE early pace, came out a bit into the turn to tighten up PROUD COMIC, narrowly showed the way through the turn, gave way in the drive.
