SHORTY SMALL allowed the pace to go early toward the inside, moved out for the drive, late bid, good late energy to be edging away late. SENOR SMILEY pressed the pace, dueled through the turn off the inside, gained the advantage upper stretch, could not contain the winner, remained clear for the place. CABE behind the pace outside, four wide through the turn, improved a bit in the drive while never a serious threat. MY NEPHEW MATT broke alertly, showed the way early, dueled through the turn inside the runner up, weakened the final furlong. MARLI'S MAN lacked a closing kick off the inside. EXPLOSIVE GHAZIE five wide through the turn when well off the pace, picked off a couple of tiring foes. MCFADDEN closest to the leaders, gave way in the drive. NOT SO WILD not a threat. CAPTAIN BILLY never involved. SMOKING KIP off slow, trailed much of the way. STORM TREE steadily faded. STORMING INDY remained back throughout.
