GLOWING REPORT with the pace from the start off the inside, dueled into the lane, long drive to the wire, proved best. RANSOM ZIP broke on top, vied up front along the rail, outfinished. GERWINII in the second flight, came five wide turning into the stretch, roused, no match for the top two late, fully extended to hold the show. MISSY BISCUIT lacked speed, four wide into the stretch, staged a belated rally well out in the strip to be getting to the show horse. ST. VICKIE'S CHARM broke out, bothered foe, went evenly in lacking a late bid. KISS ME CHOCOLATE pressured the pace off the inside, gave way in the drive. BY N' BY LORD settled off the pace, had little for the drive. CASCABELLA lacked a response on the drive when asked. SONG TO THE MOON tired. TRACI'S THUNDER forced back at the start, trailed most of the way. MORE TO THE STORY was outrun. MISSISSIPPI MARTINI brushed, pushed out at the start, not a factor.
