BAG THE STORM pulled while off the pace along the inside onto the backstretch, continued to stalk, moved out, engaged the leader from the outside turning for home, edged clear under firm handling. CHAMP LAILA void of speed, saved ground, rallied up the rail, finished up willingly to earn the place. W W OLMA raced off the pace, two path second turn, between foes into lane, advanced, outkicked late for the place. ZURI'S GIRL shook clear soon after the start, set the pace while attempting to rate, vied past the furlong maker then faltered when headed by the winner. LAURA BABE bothered slightly at the start, four wide into the first turn when settling off the pace, moved a bit closer after moving out five wide turning for home, failed to sustain that effort the final furlongs. STRAIGHT SCOOP turned in an even effort in racing one paced and evenly throughout. OUR MISS BROOKSIDE raced well back early, improved through some traffic second turn, five wide into the lane, lacked a final kick. SARAVA'S SENSATION last away, trailed, picked off a few tiring foes while never a threat. HIGH BRITE CIELO five wide into the first turn, continued outside, six wide exiting the final turn, tired. POMEROY GIRL closest to the pace for five furlongs, gave way when in traffic late in the final bend. NORTHERN WINN forwardly placed outside, stopped.
