PULPIT'S SECRET unhurried in the early going after being bothered and put in tight at the start, began to move early in the turn, fanned six wide out of the turn, finished full of run to win going away. MERCADIAN pushed out at the start, quickly straightened to set the pace toward the inside, vied, clear into the lane, proved no match for the winner late, comfortably clear for the place. SILENT SCORE lacked speed, raced well back, rallied through traffic through the lane to earn the show, no match for the top two./ COURT'S JOURNEY bumped at the start, raced outside, came five wide out of the turn, finished up evenly in lacking a serious kick. GRAN TORINE took up at the start, staged a mild rally while well out in the strip to improve position. CORPORATE CHARLIE bumped at the start, dueled outside the runner up for a half and weakened. KID YOU NOT showed little in a dull effort. HOLY PATOOIE bumped at the start, raced forwardly for four furlongs and gave way. SUPRISE ENDING mid pack early, backed up in the drive.
