SARATOGA SEVEN five wide into and through the turn, hooked up for a long drive, proved best. MR BUBBA vied up front in the early going, set down for the drive just off the inside, slightly larger lead when straightened for home, game try. EXPLOSIVE GHAZIE last away, trailed early, moved out, came six wide into the stretch, angled in and was coming late. HENSLEY with the pace three wide, did not have enough have enough in the late going. I KNOW IT'S TRUE behind the pace, in some traffic toward the inside midstretch, went evenly when clear. SOUTH BRANCH STORM off the pace, moved closer in traffic late in the turn, also lacked a late punch. PULASKI RUNNER raced back and off the inside, angled out to be four wide turning for home, failed to rally. HADNOT with the pace four wide, faded. FOX ACADEMY with the pace along the inside, was tiring when in tight midstretch.
