Footnotes

COSTA DE ORO off the early pace well out in the strip, six wide into the turn, challenged seven wide exiting the bend, set down for the drive, edged clear late. SPIRIT UNBROKEN forwardly placed off the rail, squeezed back four wide and between foes into the lane, tight again a furlong out, roused when clear, slight drift in, finished willingly to earn the place. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF CROOK'S BODGIT AGAINST SPIRIT UNBROKEN FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE THROUGH THE STRETCH WAS NOT ALLOWED. AMBER'S SHORTY forwardly placed, vied five wide and between rivals through the turn, continued to vie stretch, could not match the winner late, caught final strides for the place. WHERE'S WINSTON moved up early to vie into the turn, three wide, equal terms with the winner a furlong out, drifted out, weakened to finish up evenly. QUARTERS lacked early foot, raced behind a wall of horses when creeping closer out of the turn, steadied repeatedly when having no where to run from outside the furlong grounds to just before the wire. WISEMAN'S BLUFF within striking distance, vied six wide and between rivals through the turn and into the stretch, lacked a late kick. CROOK'S BODGIT closest to the early leader, contested the issue four wide and between rivals through the bend, was beginning to tire when in tight midstretch, steadied, fell back. CASSOULET clear early, continued to show the way through the turn by a narrow margin closest to the inside, gave way.
