STORMIN K J broke on top, soon got clear, shrugged off a mild bid late in the turn, remained clear in the drive under steady handling. MARVELOUS PEACE chased the winner from along the inside, moved out for the drive, could do little with the winner in the drive, clearly second best. HAZEL DELL BELLE within striking distance off the inside, one paced through the stretch, lasted for the show. HALF A KISS cut off at the start, moved up to the middle of the pack, also went evenly in the drive in lacking a winning bid. LA BOELEA broke slowly, well back for a half toward the inside, moved out, improved after finding best stride too late. SUAVE AFFAIR void of any early foot, saved ground into the lane, passed some tiring foes late while never a threat. FATHER'S DREAM made little impact. ALITTLEMEANSALOT closest to the winner early, brief bid late in the turn, stopped in the drive. SHESASUSPECT five wide through the turn when off the pace, lacked a rally. KEEPER HUMBLE broke out and bobbed, six wide late in the turn, faded through the lane. RUN DON'T WALK was finished early, far back.
