BOBCAT JIM broke alertly, showed the way early off the inside, shook clear in upper stretch, drew out while being kept to pressure. FEVERNTHEFUNKHOUSE pressured the winner from along the inside early, steadied slightly into the turn, fell back and lost position, came back in game fashion for the place spot while not a threat to the winner. OUR DOUBLE PLAY back off the early pace outside, ranged up into contention while three wide late in the turn, flattened out from between rivals and was outkicked for the place. DONTCHANGETRAINERS back off the early pace, advanced five wide through the turn, also failed to sustain that advance in the drive. SMOKEY DEPUTY off a step slow, raced well back, came on the outside, found best stride too late down the middle of the strip. COTTON WON lacked speed, was four wide out of the turn, lacked a serious late bid. MANEWAL within striking distance, moved a bit closer while three wide late in the turn, faltered in the drive. CARIBBEAN STORM backed up along the inside. STREET HOSS raced briefly forward, began a steady retreat before a half.
