Footnotes

TEUFLESBERG bobbled at the start, showed the way into the first turn in hand, continued to set the pace up the backstretch while firmly rated, asked for some run turning for home, had plenty left to hold the runner up safe in the late going. OFFICER ROCKET (GB) unhurried early, moved up the inside to be closer late backstretch, shuffled back while continuing inside second turn, switched to the outside turning for home, finished willingly to be getting to the winner. FORTY GRAMS prompted the pace from the three path, continued in a striking position into the stretch, lacked a winning punch. HARD SPUN taken in hand at the start, five then four wide through the first turn while continued to be restrained, loomed closer four wide to become a threat in the second turn, failed to sustain that effort in the drive. XCHANGER close up along the inside, moved out a bit into the far turn, raced in some traffic, came four wide into the lane, little late gain. GOING BALLISTIC fell back to trail, made little impact in the drive. STARBASE forwardly placed on the outside, gave way. OUR SACRED HONOR broke in the air, was a non factor. I GOT A DREAM finished early, far back.
