Footnotes

HONKY TONK SLEW off the pace, angled out to be five wide when advancing late in the turn, bid soon after, edged away under steady handling. DANCING DUDETE fell steadily back, began to advance late in the turn, split foes entering the stretch, again late, finished willingly but could not catch the winner. HOUR CLASSIC narrowly set the pace along the inside, weakened in the late going. SWEET LOVIN dueled up front off the inside, also faltered in the late going. SENSE OF HOME forwardly placed three wide, had little left in the late going. CONSENSUAL last away, lacked speed, improved position a bit while continuing toward the inside. ALASKAN TIZZY lacked a rally outside. DEVIL NOT ME four out to six wide in the turn, remained back. HOLLY IN SUMMER within striking distance, was beginning to fade when pushed out turning for home.
