DYNAMIC FORCE outrun in the early going, began to move closer while late in the turn, waited for clear room a furlong out, split foes, proved best. SIR JOCK broke in, bumped, also lacked early foot, came five wide out of the turn when beginning to rallied, finished willingly to be up for the place while widest late. RATIFY within striking distance, saved ground through the turn, moved out for the drive, did not have enough for the place, narrowly garnered the show. LEOPOLD BLOOM steadied just after the start, raced in the second flight while four wide out of the turn, lacked a winning kick. GOLDEN AGE angled in just after the start, raced forwardly and three wide, also lacked a closing punch while between foes late. GREY KNIGHT pushed in just after the start, sprinted clear, pace until late, faltered. CRESRAN chased, gave way. GARRET'S PROSPECT pinched back at the start, trailed much of the way. ALABAMA VOW broke out, bumped, was finished early.
