MY MY MY MARIA never far back, continued to stalk three wide through the turn, challenged on the outside entering the stretch, roused right handed, fully extended to edge clear late. DAKOTA SIS narrowly set the pace along the inside, vied into the lane while continuing to save ground, gave ground grudgingly to the winner, held the place. LOTTERY LASS off the pace, waited briefly along the inside late in the turn, got through, lacked finishing kick. SHEZALADYANNE within striking distance while three wide, went evenly down the lane while also lacking a winning kick. ADDABUCK lacked speed, five wide out of the turn, angled in, improved position while not a serious threat. FABULOUS FERN lacked a response in the drive. MOTEL TAN lacked speed, angled out a bit to be four wide turning for home, not a threat. MADAM FLATTER BY sluggish in the early going to fall well back, continued to trail through the turn, lodged a mild rally with some belated interest after the issue had been decided. EL DEIRDRE had little for the drive. JAYASHRI pressured the pace for a half, gave way in the drive. ART OF DECEPTION was never close. R U'S GOLDEN LADY faded five wide.
