GRAND PRELUDE outrun in the early going off the inside, asked along midway on the turn, swung out five wide turning for home, no match winner, clear for the place. INDOCTRINATION evenly paced off the inside, lacked a winning response in the drive, finished up best of the rest. HAPTOWN broke in, raced off the pace toward the inside, switched out for the drive, staged a mild rally to improve position. MACH TWELVE lacked a serious late bid. ROMAN FLAME settled off the pace toward the inside, lacked a late bid. MAJOR DUOMO away in good order, pressured the winner for a half and then gave way in the drive. COOLER KING bothered at the start, raced well back, five wide out of the turn, picked off a couple of tiring rivals. ALI FRAZIER backed up through the lane. FABLEDZAPPER was never a threat. TALENTED JOSEPH pinched back at the start, outrun.
