ABSINTHE MINDED away in good order, took control into the first turn, set a legit pace along the inside, appeared to break stride slightly past the gate tracks with a sixteenth to run, continued to be kept to task late. SATANS QUICK CHICK last to leave, raced well back into the first turn, continued near the rear in the run up the backstretch, began to advance far turn, angled out four wide for the drive, finished willingly to earn the place while no threat to the winner. TIZ MIZ SUE settled within striking distance along the inside, lacked a closing kick when the real running started at the head of the lane. SHE'S ALL IN also raced toward the front, three wide most of the way, came up empty for the drive as well. SEEKING THE TITLE lacked early foot while in hand, saved some ground into the lane, roused with a brisk left handed stick, showed some belated interest while out in the strip. TAPTAM prompted the pace, had nothing left for the drive. BE FAIR evenly paced while out in the strip, failed to respond when asked turning for home. DYNAMIC BARBIE trailed throughout in a dull effort.
