**Footnotes**

BRUSH WITH PRIDE raced unhurried early, made a strong move four wide in the second turn, challenged when straightened for home and outfinished LITTLEBITLIVELY after a long drive. The latter, a pace factor off the inside, raced between rivals in the second bend, garnered the advantage into the stretch and dug in gamely to miss. TREAT ME DOC stalked the pace outside, loomed a threat in the second turn then flattened out a bit in the drive. SCOTT'S SCOUNDREL set or forced the pace off the inside and weakened. RHONESQUARTERSWISH came out at the start then made little impact. BATTLE MOUNTAIN, last away after having his head turned at the start, was five wide turning for home. RELIC REWARD vied for the lead along the inside and gave way before six furlongs.
