QUIET ECLIPSE away in good order, set the pace just off the inside and gave ground grudgingly. HAWK N THE SHEIKH lacked early foot then staged a mild rally to be along for the show. JAYLA raced closest to the leader for a half then weakened in the drive. HONG KONG SQUALL made little impact. LEAFLET fell back well back then picked up a couple of tiring foes after the issue had been decided. CINDERELLA STORY forwardly placed early inside, faded. L'ILLA (MEX) gave way badly in the drive.
