SITUATE THIS forwardly placed from the start, fell back a bit late in the turn, came back to challenge inside the furlong marker, edged clear. THISHEARTSFORYOU within striking distance, four wide through the turn, bid, shook clear, faltered. BEAUTIFUL AND ABLE allowed to settle off the pace, came four wide out of the turn, rallied down the lane, getting to the winner. OILVE OIL TOO off the pace, came four wide out of the turn, angled out, improved slightly. A P DILLY off a step slow, raced back, found best stride too late. BEAUTIFUL CHAMPION lacked speed, came five wide out of the turn while between foes, improved position while no real threat. KIPLING HAWK devoid of early foot, six wide exiting the turn, picked off some tiring foes. PROUDEST HEART five wide through the turn, lacked a rally. LAURA RACHEL showed little in a dull effort. SEWILLA WIN was finished early. DOLLY PARTEE chased the early leader, gave way. FARE WEATHER STORM broke on top, set the pace for a half, stopped when headed.
