GREEN GLORY lacked speed along the inside, moved out turn, switched out further nearing the furlong marker, finished full of run to be in time. MARGIE MARIE pressured the early leader off the inside, took over turning for home, well clear, shortened stride and could not contain the winner. STORMING SUZY bothered, off slowly, trailed early, roused for the drive, staged a mild, belated rally. DIXIE PIXIE within striking distance in the early going, came up empty for the drive. LIKE CANDY broke out, bothered foe, settled off the pace, lacked a late response. SAND PLUM in the second flight for a half, had little left for the drive. HALO'S REFLECTION failed to respond in the drive. RITA'S GOLD sprinted clear early, showed the way for a half, gave way when headed entering the stretch. SCAMP AND A HALF was through early, trailed home.
