SHRADED EDGE with the pace from the start, dueled off the inside in the run up the backstretch, between foes into the lane, garnered a larger lead inside the furlong marker, held the runner up safe late under firm handling. HAPTOWN forwardly placed, stalked in the second flight up the backstretch, closer second turn, lost some ground to the winner turning for home, getting back to that foe late. DON DULCE lacked speed, remained back into the lane, angled out, brushed, continued to move out a bit as was going best of all at the end. OBLIGINGLY vied up front closest to the rail, dueled inside the winner, weakened in the drive. CHANNELING settled off the pace, had little for the drive. A STUDENT last away, trailed much of the way in showing little. FORGOTTEN KNOT five wide in the first turn, fell back and failed to rally. WESTSHORE four wide in the first turn, moved in a bit to save a little ground onto the backstretch, in hand, faded.
