**Footnotes**

LUNARPEAL outrun in the early going, came four wide when beginning to rally into the stretch, carried out in a bit when challenging with less than a furlong remaining, edged clear late. PACIFIC STAR set or forced the pace off the inside, drifted out a bit inside the furlong grounds, could not match the winner late, remained clear for the place. MAN O' WONDER evenly paced off the leaders, angled out to be widest the final furlong, up for the show. TRIPLE NINE FINE within striking distance, raced three wide through the turn, lacked a finishing kick. MALABAR BLUES raced four wide through the turn when forcing the issue, had little left for the stretch run. WIDE CLYDE void of early foot, came wide into the stretch, improved position slightly while never dangerous. AZTEC KING vied up front along the inside, faltered in the drive. PORT HUENEME five wide into and through the turn, failed to rally. RED FALCON was never a threat. CATO trailed throughout.
