LITTLE MONTIE unhurried early, lodged a strong move outside in the second turn, bid, quickly clear, held the runner up safe in the late going. FROSTY GENERAL broke alertly, fell back off the pace, began a three wide rally in the far turn, drifted but still finished willingly to be getting to the winner. TIZ A SCHOLAR void of speed, four wide gain into the stretch, carried out by the runner up late, clear of the others. TO THE MOON off the pace and the inside, lacked the necessary late bid. YEMEN last away, devoid of early foot, outside, five wide turning for home, improved with a mild rally, never dangerous. TOBY THE COAL MAN used a bit in the early going on the outside, pressed the issue in the run up the backstretch, took over far turn, weakened in the drive. MOUNTAIN FIGHTER broke in then was in a bit tight, lacked speed, made little impact in the drive. CIGAR BREAK five wide late in the final turn, lacked a late kick. POPPAS HALF behind the first flight for six furlongs, tired in the drive. FARE CIELO jostled at the start, quickly recovered to set the pace, gave way far turn. PERTINENT was outrun. DALAINEY'S FRIEND vied up front in the early going, stopped.
