HEAVENLY ALIBI bothered slightly at the start, moved outside for the run up the backstretch, five out to six wide in the second turn, took over turning for home, fully extended stretch to prove best. KERISMA back off the pace, advanced and got through along the rail turning for home, bid, proved stubborn until the end. CARNIVAL KID settled off the pace, remained within striking distance the middle half, lost some position in some traffic second turn, between foes into the lane, finished up best of the rest. BOX OFFICE APPEAL in a bit tight at the start, moved closer while five wide midway on the final turn, flattened out a bit in the drive, flattened out in the drive. IMMA BEE SEXY within striking distance, moved slightly closer to challenge between rivals in the second turn, briefly vied, hung in the drive. CAPETOWN REBEL broke out, straightened to set or force the pace in the two path, allowed the runner the rail turning for home, began to weaken soon after. MAINE D'OR last to leave, trailed, failed to threaten. REMEMBER THIS vied up front three path, gave way in the drive.
