LA REASON brushed at the start, settled in second flight off rail, between foes into the lane, took over, briefly clear, all out to hold off the pacesetter off who was trying to come back. BALLROOM DEPUTY broke on top, set a soft pace, headed by the winner, fell back off that one, trying to come back in the late going. PLATINUM BALLET lacked pace, asked in traffic turning for home, belated rally for the show. DADDY'S PETUNIA well back, improved position along the inside, never a serious threat for the win. PRIVATE GIFT firmly rated off the soft pace, raced in some traffic turning for home, came up empty for the drive. COMMERCIALIZE off the pace, came five wide into the lane, lacked a late bid. CULINARY settled off the pace, had nothing for the drive. WINNING SEASON prompted the slow fractions while off the rail, gave way when the real running started at the head of the lane.
