Footnotes

MOON DANCING rank start in spotting the field a couple of lengths, continued unsettled into the first turn, steadied across a rival's heels, advanced with an early move outside, vied through the second turn between foes, took over nearing the furlong marker, drew clear under steady handling. INERTIA settled off the pace, saved ground through the second turn, angled out for the drive, up for the place in the late going while not a serious threat to the winner. COMPED AT THE CAL well clear before a quarter, sucked back to be challenged onto the backstretch, clear again before a half, vied through the second turn, closest to the inside, continued on equal terms with the winner upper stretch, could not match that rival the final furlong, caught final strides for the place. NOCTIVAGANT well off the early pace, steadied early backstretch, fell back to trail, advanced, got out to be six wide turning for home, lugged in badly to bother SLIGO BREEZE a furlong out, some late interest. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE STRETCH RUN, NOCTIVAGANT WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM FOURTH AND PLACED SIXTH. BEER N CRICKETS off the pace for five furlongs, ranged up to challenge four wide in the second turn, failed to maintain that advance through the stretch. SLIGO BREEZE void of early foot, advanced five wide far turn, forced in and bothered with a furlong to run, finished up evenly. ROCKIN MOMMA chased early, challenged early backstretch, chased again late backstretch, challenged and vied four wide through the second turn, gave way in the drive.
