DUBLIN ROSE closest to the pace, took control exiting the turn, got well clear then held GOODGOLLYMISSPOLLY safe late. The latter, outrun early, raced in traffic through the turn, came four wide into the stretch, was set down and finished well to be getting to the winner. MAKIN' CALLS, a forward factor off the inside, finished best of the others. WHISPER AND RUN came out at the start then improved her position while wide in the drive. MISS SAY GOODBYE, bothered at the break, lacked a winning response. WHAT A BOUT had a wide trip after coming out at the start and soundly bumping TIMETOENJOYLIFE. MATINEE AFFAIR lacked a rally. PASSION CREEK tired from her early efforts. SHE'S A STARLET set the pace for a half and stopped. PAULA FIELDS faded four wide. TIMETOENJOYLIFE, bumped soundly at the start trailed.
