Footnotes

DR. JAJO outrun in the early going, angled in a bit to save some ground and be three wide into the turn, swept to the front while angling out six wide turning for home, clear, driving. JENNY'S TOUCH in the second group and inside the winner, four wide challenge exiting the turn, could not match that same foe the final furlong, held sway for the place. GONE COWBOY off the pace early, lacked clear room along the rail late in the turn, moved out, roused, finished up willingly to be getting to the runner up late. SIR SHERMAN within striking distance, moved closer in some traffic late turn, squeezed back while five wide into the lane, recovered and finished up evenly. TASTE THE TRUTH vied up front while three wide, weakened in the drive. EXOTIC WILDCAT narrowly set the pace for three furlongs closest to the inside, weakened. CABLES HALO contested the pace until a quarter remained while between foes and faltered. BUSY DREAMIN last to leave, trailed, continued in sluggish fashion through the turn, distanced after losing contact with the field through the stretch.
