MENDENHALL in the second flight on the outside, asked for some run midway on the turn, engaged the leader a furlong out and proved best under firm handling. WILD PARTY broke on top, dueled up front closest to the inside, disposed of the other speed upper stretch, responded when the winner came along side soon after and proved stubborn to the end. BARNEY R back off the pace, came five wide into the stretch when roused, staged a modest rally to annex the show. DENALI HOLY BULL alternated up front outside the runner up, weakened in the drive. BRUCEVILLE closest to the leaders in the early going, began to retreat before a half while off the inside. BETTE'S AFTERSHOCK never menaced in trailing throughout.
