Footnotes

B'WANAGOLDMINE allowed the pace to go early while angling in a bit to save some ground first turn, advanced on the outside late in the second turn, engaged the leader turning for home and wore that foe down. MINIMAST broke out, straightened, narrowly set the pace early inside, got well clear before a half, maintained a daylight advantage into the far turn, responded when challenged by the winner entering the stretch, gave ground grudgingly to that rival, remained clear for the place. COWBOY CADILLAC lacked speed, advanced three wide and in some traffic in the second turn, along for the show. MY LEIGH VY away alertly, allowed the leader to go after a quarter, chased that one into the far turn, had little more for the drive and was caught late for the show. LUMBERJACK CAT void of speed, passed tiring rivals. I NEED A BALEOUT crowded at the start, went evenly in lacking a late bid. REEL PRIME crowded start, settled in the middle of the pack, lacked a late bid. EPICURUS delayed the start by being a bit reluctant to load, raced back and outside, tired

in the drive. RAVENSWORTH raced briefly forward, steadily faded. DEVIL'S APPRENTICE lacked early foot, made little impact. GRUENEWALD trailed, outrun.
