JENNY KAY, forward from the start outside, took command after a half, drew clear and steadily increased her advantage to win ridden out. TOWER OF ANGELS, outrun for five furlongs, rallied four wide late in the second bend and was edging clear for the place. ALUMA settled off the pace, was four wide into the far turn then went evenly to the wire. ROSE OF CIMARRON went evenly. ITSAPRINCESS, within striking distance, failed to respond when the real running started. BABY BABY BABY failed to menace off the rail. SURE RUNAWAY picked up a couple of tiring rivals. INLAY raced five wide early in the first turn and then tired. VOILE D'OR saved ground to no avail. TOO COOLTODANCE was never close. BARNIE FIFE set the early pace and stopped badly.
