**Footnotes**

LABELLED in the second flight outside, four wide most of the way, fell back off the leader again into the stretch, late bid, up. JOYCE G off a step slow, roused when angling out five wide for the drive, finished willingly between foes to be up for the place. NORTHERN WINN off slowly, moved up quickly to be clear into the first turn, set pace while in hand, opened up a larger advantage when straightened for home, could not last. HEART ACK ROAD lacked speed, early traffic, raced four then five into the stretch, staged a rally but did not have enough for the place while widest in the drive. D' CODE off the pace, came four wide out of the final turn, displayed some mild late interest while between foes. DIXIE HEARTH within striking distance on the outside, lodged a mild bid second turn, faltered in the drive. HOLD ME MOLLY within striking distance toward the inside, was tiring when shuffled back second turn, continued to tire. SAFE N RICH remained always back. MISS SNOW NOSE was outrun. KARACUDA prompted the pace, gave way late in the final turn.
