SLEEK RIDGE moved up to pressure the leader off the inside and in hand, continued to force the issue under restraint turn, took over into the lane, drew off as he pleased to win ridden out. GOOD BY JESTER slow to settle, was well back in the turn, swung out six wide turning for home, finished willingly for the place down the middle of the strip while no threat to the winner. MADE THE CUT raced in the middle of the pack three wide, behind some traffic in the turn, finished up best of the rest while no match for the top two. HOWDY DOODY TIME within striking distance, lacked a late kick. CLARE'S REPORT bothered at the start, five wide into the turn, moved inside, improved inside of several rivals into the stretch, failed to sustain that advance in the drive. HAYDAY'S PAYDAY broke alertly, set the pace for a half toward the inside, gave way when headed by the winner entering the stretch. ROYAL BIDDER off a bit slow, floated out seven wide out of the turn, passed tiring foes after the issue had been decided. MAGICAL STORM within striking distance in the four path, weakened. MARKED TEXAN fractious in the post parade, steadied just after the start, raced wide, slight bother by the runner up upper stretch, greenly. PLEASANTLY SUNNY never a factor. JESSE'S GOLD TOO was also never close. INSOMNIAC forwardly placed early, in hand late in the turn while in hand, continued to back up.
