JIMMER broke in, bumped start, midpack early, advanced into the turn, split foes entering the stretch, drew clear and held sway late in a professional debut. SARK broke out, bumped at the start, showed the way early, vied through the turn off the inside, 3w into the lane, clear for the place. BOOMER off slowly, raced in traffic early, steadied, shuffled back into the turn, lost position, improved through traffic into the lane, finished up best of the rest. LIMEHOUSE BLUES slow early, continued to trail turn inside, roused for the drive, improved position with a mild rally through traffic. DOUBLE RAH RAH within striking distance, four wide into the lane, lacked a late kick. NIGHT SEEKER off the the pace, four out to five wide in the turn, failed to rally. EARLY EDDIE jostled at the start, pressured the leader early, vied inside of that rival through the turn, weakened in the drive. STORM ON THE LOOSE forwardly placed in the early going toward the inside, retreated. SINISTER INTENT tired four wide. SLAMMING G off slowly, never close.
