CRYPTOLIGHT lacked speed, moved closer the second quarter, stalked into the second turn, four wide into the lane when advancing, finished willingly to be clear late. SPOTSGONE broke on top, showed the way through a quick opening quarter, continued to set the pace, could not contain the winner, held the place. READY SET within striking distance early inside, fell well back, continued to save ground second turn, mild late rally while in a bit tight along the rail late. DOC'S FRIEND prompted the pace the middle half while off the inside, moved up to challenge between foes in the second turn, weakened the final furlong. MARILYN'S GUY back off the early pace, advanced with a middle move into contention, challenged three wide second turn, flattened out. KING A. J. broke in the air and never serious menaced. PREMIUM WINE vied early, stopped, bled.
