Footnotes

INTOTHEWILD close from the start outside, moved on the leader through the turn, took over into the stretch, edged clear. DEPAUL raced toward the front and the inside, moved out turning for home, could do little with the winner in the late going, well clear for the place. MILITARY LEGEND lacked speed, made a mild advance along the inside, moved out for the drive, along for the show in the two path, never a serious threat. HI PRIM showed the way along the inside, vied through the turn, weakened when headed turning for home. BROKEN FREE last to leave, trailed for a half, picked off a couple of tiring foes with some modest late interest. REEL PRIME was never a threat. SATELLITE TRICK four wide out of the turn while still within contact of the leaders, retreated through the stretch. WHATS UP MACK forwardly placed in the early going, steadily faded.
