UNCLE BRENT vied up front in the early going, cleared to the inside, maintained a daylight advantage through the lane under steady handling. JERRY N' ELVIS forwardly placed while off the inside, chased three wide through the turn, could not get to the winner in the drive, clearly second best. SKITCHING vied early, fell back, four wide out of the turn, no match for the top two. BETSY'S BOY off the pace, raced five wide through the turn while still well behind the leaders, went evenly through the stretch. BIG BAD BUTCH in traffic early, steadied, fell back, failed to get involved through the stretch. DESANI'S CHANCE within striking distance early in some traffic, shuffled back a bit into the turn, lacked a late bid. SASHA'S KING off a bit slow, trailed most of the way and was never a factor. LEMON GHOST bobbled at the start, quickly recovered to briefly set the pace, stopped.
