### Footnotes

COSTA DE ORO forwardly placed inside, inherited the advantage when SORROWFUL JONES bore out turning for home, soon got clear, kept to task. LEE'S SOUTH closest to the leader, shuffled back in traffic midway on the turn, also slipped through inside of trouble and rivals into the lane, no match winner, clear for the place. TRULY INSPIRED five wide into the turn when in a forward position, carried out extremely wide by SORROWFUL JONES exiting the turn, straightened up and finished up willingly to earn the show while remaining far out in the strip. SORROWFUL JONES broke alertly, clear soon after, continued to show the way into the turn, bore out late in the bend to lose the advantage, did not have much late and was outkicked for the show. CAJUN DIABLO in traffic when off the pace in the turn, lacked late kick. POLITICAL AGENDA also in some traffic through the turn while closer to the inside, came up empty in the drive as well.
