Footnotes

ABITA INDIGO vied up front while in hand and three wide early, roused upper stretch, drifted, drew out. NOON DELIGHT with the pace along the inside, could not match the winner the final furlong, all out to hold the place. MONASETAH raced off the pace early while off the inside, moved closer while five wide late in the turn, bothered slightly when straightened for home, modest late interest to be best of the rest. LADY JAMEELA lacked early foot, continued back while four wide through the turn, improved a bit in the late going. CHARLEY'S HOPE failed to seriously menace while toward the inside through the stretch. SPRING CHOIR off a bit slow, advanced, loomed a threat four wide late in the bend, weakened in the drive while drifting. HIGH vied up front for less than a half while between foes then gave way. DANZIGWITHTHESTARZ off a bit slow, wiped out when LOOKIN SHARP swerved in abruptly, lost rider. LOOKIN SHARP broke in then swerved in toward the gap, lost rider.
