Footnotes

COMEDERO with the pace from the start, vied between foes, garnered a larger advantage in the turn, shook clear upper stretch, drew out, kept to task. BACKWATER BLUES off the pace, advanced four then three wide through the turn, could not do much with the winner in the drive, narrowly managed to hold the place. ACTIVITY REPORT off the pace, slight steady outside into the bend, raced five wide through the turn, roused, missed the place while remaining well out in the strip. DON'T PUT IT BACK in the second flight toward the inside early, called on for some run into the lane, failed to respond and was going evenly at the end. GRAND SLAM ANDRE well off the pace while in some traffic into the turn, also lacked a significant response in the drive. BIORRA last away, trailed for a half, picked off a few tiring foes while not a serious threat. VITO FILITTO broke well, raced forwardly inside early, began a steady fade early in the turn. HENRY'S TIME with the pace for three furlongs, also gave way in the drive. PERFECT DRIVE pressured the early pace, stopped.
