Footnotes

KEOWEE CLAI bothered slightly start, vied up front three wide early, dueled through the turn and into the stretch off the inside, long drive, brushed, fully extended to prove narrowly best. HEAVENLY APPEAL moved up inside to contest the issue soon after the start, raced on equal terms inside the winner through the bend and much of the stretch, brushed with that same rival, proved stubborn to the end. DONE within striking distance well off the rail, proved no match for the top two in the drive. OPTIMISTIC SREVA behind the pace inside early, moved out to be three wide late in the turn, lacked a late kick in going evenly to the wire. SPLASH OF ROSES lacked speed, improved slightly while never dangerous. ZIPPY WAGER off slowly, never threatened. DO THE TIGER carried out four wide exiting the turn, faded. FORWARD SAIL broke out, raced briefly forward and stopped before a half.
