PAGE MEADOWS broke very sharp, soon got clear, given a breather through the turn, maintained a daylight advantage through the stretch under steady handling. FROGGYVILLE broke in a bit, raced back and outside, six wide into the stretch, finished up willingly to be slowly getting to the winner late. RAZZO SUCCO brushed in the early going, settled off the pace, two path into the lane, proved game for the place while not a stretch to the top two. NOW AND ZEN brushed early, raced back off the pace, lacked a late kick and was outkicked for the show. LEMON JUICE settled in mid pack while off the inside, five wide into the lane, failed to muster a rally. RIGHT SQUALL off slowly, remained back throughout. NEXT RIGHT THING jostled at the start, chased the winner for a half and then gave way in the drive. AFFAIR trailed throughout, showed little.
