HAWAIIAN SKY stalked the two leaders, engaged that pair from the outside turning for home, fully extended to narrowly prevail. MISSY MINER vied up front along the inside, held on stubbornly to the end. COUGAR NIGHT last away, trailed well off the rail, came five wide into the stretch when beginning to rally, was going well at the end to be getting to the top two. CHERRY PINK settled off the pace, saved ground through the second turn, lacked a significant late response. ALBERT'S OLLIE lacked speed, came four wide out of the final turn, improved position a bit while never dangerous. UNO RED BIRD four wide both turns, in some traffic in the second turn, went evenly down the lane. MOLLY WILL PASS pace off the rail, gave way through traffic turning for home. ARCTIC EVA was finished early. LET'SPLAYGORGEIOUS staged a steady retreat.
