OCEAN ROAD steadied at the start, fell back, five wide into the first turn, outside advance, bid, long drive, just up at wire. I'M COZY sprinted clear to set the pace, soft fractions, continued to lead stretch, gave ground grudgingly to the winner in the late going. SILVER PROSPECTS broke on top, fell back off the pace, lost some additional position in the second turn, two path into the lane, came again for the show. RENEGADE BAND four wide in the first turn when forwardly placed, continued to race four wide in the second turn, lacked a late punch. FRANNIE G forwardly placed, second flight in the final turn, three wide into the lane, lacked a winning response. RAHAB YOUR SOUL closest to the leader early, vied the middle half mile outside the runner up, weakened in the drive. SAKURA BALLERINA brushed at the start in being the last to leave, continued to trail, picked off a couple of tiring rivals while not a threat. SMARTY PARTY never a factor. EVIL ATTITUDE settled in mid pack for a half, weakened.
